The Art of Gambling

In theory, the Picasso picture "Le Rêve" should not be in this "The Art of Gambling" section of our magazine, as it makes no reference to any aspect of gaming.

US magnate Steve Wynn, owner of several Mega-Casinos in the USA and current owner of the picture, this year ensured that it became one of the most famous images in the gaming world.

On 18 October, Wynn, who acquired "Le Rêve" in 1977 for \$48.5 million, was about to sell it to US hedge fund multimillionaire Steve Cohen, for no less than \$139 million, making it the most expensive painting of all time.

"Le Rêve" depicts Picasso's lover and muse, Marie-Thérèse Walter.

When Wynn was proudly showing the picture to his intimate friends for the last time, he knocked it awkwardly with his elbow, making a hole about the size of a silver dollar right in the centre of the canvas. All he could say was, "Thank God it was me".

The sale has been cancelled at the express wish of Wynn's wife, who believes that the incident was a sign that they were meant to keep the painting.
